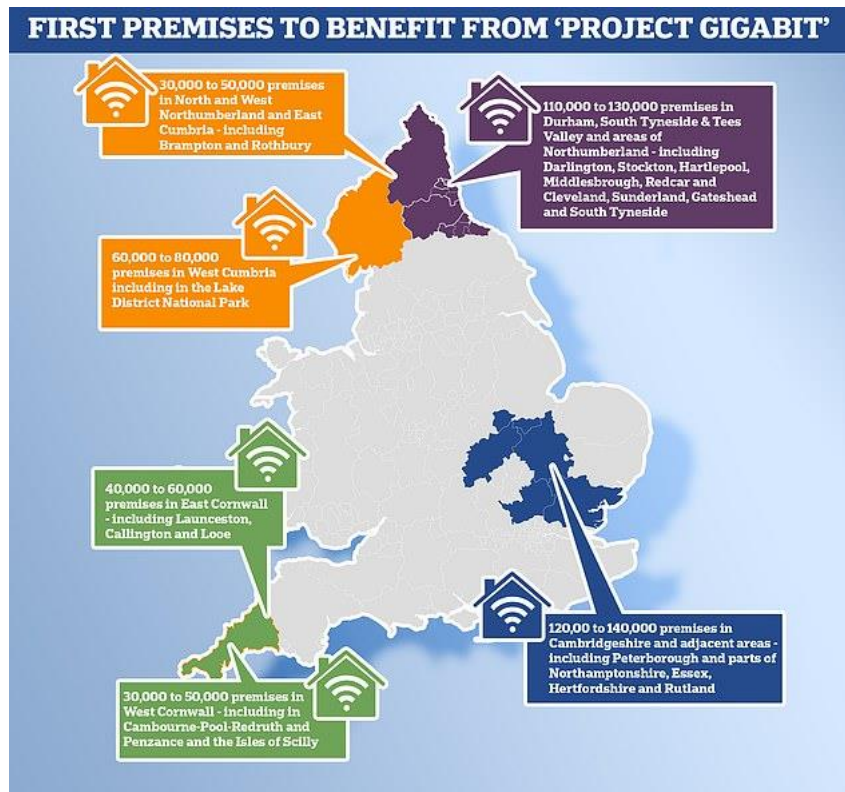
We are delighted to count Kosc Telecom, a subsidiary of Altitude Infra, among the new customers of Setics Sttar.

New tenders coming to the UK

The UK, which has been one of the slowest countries in Europe to take up fibre broadband, is making great strides to catch up. The recent FTTH Council Europe forecasts showed that in the period from September 2019 to September 2020, the number of homes passed in terms of FTTH/B grew by 64%.

This **expansion** will be **greatly enhanced by the forthcoming Project Gigabit**, the government-backed scheme to achieve at least 85% gigabit coverage by 2025 for England. In a number of tenders starting shortly, there are 38 planned Regional Contracts (for 50-150,000 homes each) and maybe 100 Local Contracts (for c5,000 homes each). In total £1.25bn has been committed for this programme, with £5bn potentially available eventually to reach 100% coverage.
